Where is it?

• It is right beside the Kincardine Bridge. This is the Scottish Police Academy. It is in a castle of some charm but with conference facilities and large grounds. All rooms are ensuite, single or double with some disabled rooms. You can look at their website if you put the address into a Google search.

How do I get there?

There is no train station in Kincardine. The nearest train stations are either Alloa or Dunfermline. The buses to take are either the 15 bus from Alloa or X24 X26 X27 from Dunfermline. Buses go every 20 minutes.

There is a 15/20 minute walk from the bus stop to the college. If you would like a lift we will collect you from the bus stop.

- From Elgin it should take just over 3 ¼ hours by car.
- From Aberdeen 3 ½ hours by train and bus train to Stirling then 15 bus. By car
 2 ½ hours.
- From Peniculk 2 ½ hours by bus. By car 45 minutes.
- From Perth by car 45 minutes. By bus 1 hour 50 minutes.
- From Glasgow by bus just over an hour.
- From Dumfries 3 hours 20 minutes by bus.
- From Castle Douglas 2 hours by car.
- From Ayr 1 ¼ hours by car.
