
## World Day of Prayer 2019

Last year the Scottish services were hit by extreme weather and many were cancelled and income was down almost 50% so please encourage extra generosity this year and please note services can happen at any time in the year not just on the traditional day so if the extreme weather hits us again in the coming years please re-organise for a later date, many lives are transformed every year by your generosity.
